Special Guest Biographies

CLLR ERNEST EZEJUGHI was born in Nigeria, Anambra state, he studied Science at Nnamdi Azikiwe University, earning a Bachelor's degree. Following this, he worked briefly in the family business and has lived in Brent since moving to the UK in 2004. After gaining a Master of Science at Kings College London, he has worked for several organisations including Public Health England and he currently works for the Medicine and Healthcare Regulatory Authority (MHRA) and also the Royal Mail. He was elected councillor for the Stonebridge ward in May 2014 and was re-elected in May 2018. The Mayor will be supporting two charities during his year in office:



- **Sickle Cell Society**
- **Jason Roberts Foundation**

HRM OBA ADEYEMI ADEKEYE, LAGORI III, ABEPA OF JOGA-ORILE, OGUN STATE.



He was born into the Adelupo Ruling House of Joga-Orile. He attended St. Peter's Anglican Primary School, Joga-Orile and Comprehensive High School, Aiyetoro (Compro). After leaving Compro in 1977, he had a brief stint as a Banker before leaving for the United States to study Business Administration. He returned from the U.S in 1988 and set up a Finance House in Lagos.

In 2002, he was installed Lagori III, Abepa of Joga-Orile following the demise of Oba A.S Adesina. Also, later that year he was made a Goodwill Ambassador of the City of Houston, Texas by Governor Rick Perry, now United States Secretary for Energy.

CLLR NITIN PAREKH was born in Aden, Yemen. At the age of 7, he moved to Mumbai and lived there for 20 years. He completed his education in Mumbai, with a Degree in Commerce from University of Bombay and also qualified as a Chartered Accountant.



He moved to London in later part of 1986 and he qualified as Chartered Accountant and later got a qualification in taxation.

In 1994 he became a School Governor for his sons' Primary School. Later Parekh became the Chair of the School's Finance Committee and was elected as the school Governor for eight years. He has been a member, President and Secretary of various professional and community organisations for years. Cllr Parekh was elected Mayor of Harrow in May 2019.

ABIKE DABIRI-EREWA is Broadcaster and Politician She attended Maryland Private Primary School Lagos and St. Teresa's College Ibadan. She holds a Bachelors degree in English from Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife and a Masters in Mass Communications from the University of Lagos. She also studied at the John F Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University. She started her Broadcasting career at the NTA, where she was for 15years before going into Politics. She served as a member of the Federal House of Representatives from 2007- 2011. She was the Chairman of the House Committee on Media & Publicity. In 2015, she was appointed Senior Special Adviser to President Muhammadu Buhari on Foreign Affairs and Diaspora. She is currently Chairman of the Nigerian Diaspora Commission.



OLU OLANREWAJU is a member of the Royal Institution of chartered surveyors with an MBA and part of the Directors Programme at Cranfield Business School. Olu has a wealth of experience in both the provision of affordable housing and commercial housing development and management in the United Kingdom and Africa. Prior to joining Altair as affordable and social housing expert, he was senior Executive with significant experience of leading major housing companies in the UK. He was Chief Executive of United HA based in Bristol, Managing Director of Midland Heart HA based in Birmingham, Managing Director of Genesis HA, Executive Director of Operations at East Thames and London & Quadrant, all based in London. These businesses owned and managed homes with market value from £100m to £20bn. He was until recently non-executive Chairman of Inquilab HA and currently Chairman Altwood Housing Group, a family owned private property development and management company based in London.



ADE ADETOSOYE OBE joined Bromley Council in December 2016 as the Deputy Chief Executive from the City of London Corporation where he was Director for Community and Children's Services. Ade spent seven years as the director of social care at Lambeth Council and during this time achieved outstanding by Ofsted in safeguarding and services for children in care, fostering and adoption. He was awarded an OBE in 2013.



Ade is a Trustee of Coram, the UK's first ever charity dedicated to supporting the adoption of children. He is also a Freeman of the City of London, a unique historical title that dates back to 1237, as well as being a Freeman of the Haberdashers' Company, an ancient merchant guild.

In November 2018 Bromley achieved a 'good' in all areas of the inspection on Children's Social Care Services, with an 'outstanding' in leadership – a turnaround from an 'inadequate' rating in February 2016.

In December 2018, Ade was made the interim Chief Executive and in July 2019 was offered the role of the Chief Executive.

BIYI BANDELE is a novelist, playwright and filmmaker. He was the director of feature film Half of a Yellow Sun (2013), based on the novel by Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie and starring Thandie Newton, Chiwetel Ejiofor, and John Boyega for which he also wrote the screenplay. His television work includes Not Even God is Wise Enough, a BBC2 drama directed by Danny Boyle in 1994, and Bad Boys (BBC 2, 1996) starring Clive Owen. He wrote and directed two seasons of the MTV series Shuga. From 1987-1990 he studied Drama at the University of Ife, where his play Rain won him a scholarship that brought him to the UK, which he has called home ever since. His plays have been staged at the Royal Court Theatre and have been performed by the Royal Shakespeare Company. In 1997, he adapted Chinua Achebe's Things Fall Apart for the stage, to international critical acclaim, and in 1999 wrote a new adaptation of Aphra Behn's Oroonoko. He was a Judith E. Wilson Fellow at Churchill College, Cambridge from 2000-2002, and Royal Literary Fund Resident Playwright at Bush Theatre from 2002-2003.



His second feature film Fifty, had its world premiere at the BFI London Film Festival in 2015. He was an artist-in-residence at the Tisch School of the Arts, New York University, in 2017. He is currently working on a screen adaptation of Wole Soyinka's prison memoirs The Man Died for the BFI.

ALI BABA AKPOBOME is one of Nigeria's most popular stand-up comedians. He was born in Warri, Delta State and attended Ojo Primary School and Command Secondary School in Lagos. He furthered his education at Ibru College in Agbarha-Otor and Bendel State University (now Ambrose Alli University), Ekpoma where he majored in Religious Studies & Philosophy.



He began his professional career in 1991 performing at corporate events, appearing on television shows with Patrick Doyle, Charly Boy and Danladi Bako, and making cameo appearances on radio shows with Bisi Olatilo, Sani Irabor and Mani Onumonmu. He also worked with Dapo Adelegan of DP Lekki Limited as executive assistant in 1991.

With little precedent in Nigeria for stand-up comedians, Ali Baba persevered to

professionalise his skills and carve a niche as an innovator and comedian for corporate and non-corporate events and by serving as a Master of Ceremony at many events.

Ali Baba, maintains the philosophy that his business is big enough for all who want to make comedy their chosen profession. As such, he supports, mentors and presents several comedians helping to ensure that standards are maintained and professionalism encouraged.

TAYO FATUNLA is a Nigerian Comic Artist, Author, writer and illustrator and Editorial cartoonist. He started his cartooning career drawing for Nigerian newspapers. He is a graduate of the prestigious U.S. Art school, The Kubert School in New Jersey, US. He illustrated the award-winning digital comic for the award-winning BBC World service titled HOOKED and has produced African Kingdom illustrations for The British Museum.



Tayo has published books including OUR ROOTS, OUR ROOTS - Black History sketchbook and TAYO- THRO' THE YEARS.

Tayo has also produced comic pages for DC Comics. He has held exhibitions of his cartoons and cartoon workshops in countries like the U.K., Nigeria, South Korea, Cameroon, Finland, France, Ethiopia, Spain, the U.S., Egypt, Algeria, Belgium, Italy, Israel and Ireland.

Tayo was awarded Crayon de Porcelaine for his contribution to press cartoons internationally at the Salon International Dessin de Presse & Humour, St- Just-le-Martel, France and in May 2018 TAYO was presented with the ECBACC Pioneer lifetime achievement award (PLA) for OUR ROOTS – Famous Black People in History of African heritage. He was also awarded by his alma mater, Lagos Baptist Academy (BAOSA) with an award for Professional excellence in Nigeria in 2018.

AISHA JANKI AKINOLA is a gifted student. She attended Federal Government College, Sokoto(FGCS). Aisha has always been passionate about diversity and excellence. Through FGCS and NSF(UK), she heard about African Science Academy (ASA) in Ghana and applied for the scholarship which she won.



In 2018, Aisha graduated from the ASA with distinctions in all three subjects; maths, further maths and physics. With the result she earned herself an unconditional place into the University of Edinburgh with a full Mastercard Foundation scholarship to study Architecture.

Outside of studies, Aisha is a poet, a writer, a henna artist, a bead maker, and a hair dresser. She is an advocate for female empowerment and she gives talks to people in a bid to encouraging other people because their dreams are valid too.







The broad aim of the Britain-Nigeria Educational Trust is to promote friendship and understanding between the UK and Nigeria by providing financial support that directly contributes to the progress and advancement of education in Nigeria. It is a non-pofirical and non-sectarian membership charity managed by a Board of Trustees who meet at least three times a year. The Board's policy on grants is to select projects that will contribute positively to the improvement of education, especially in areas where others are slow to help.

Teacher training is a key priority with support given to the placement of VSO volunteers in this role as well as assisting deserving teachers to raise their skills through the Trust's Tafawa Balewa Teacher Award scheme and the Distant Learning Programme run by the National Teachers Institute, Kaduna.

Current major educational projects include the building of a new secondary school for girls in Umutu, the construction and furnishing of a new 2 storey 6-classroom block and a student-hostel complex for Edo College and a new classroom and laboratory block for King's College, Lagos. Grants for books, equipment and teaching facilities are regularly given to other schools and colleges.

As part of the Trust's strategy to make a noticeable impact on education a five-year fellowship Plan, has been awarded to Ibadan University to assist its planned programme of development as an international centre for postgraduate training and research. The Fellowship funds the placement of a senior academic to work with the university in all aspects of teaching, supervision, mentoring and research.

A valuable and regular income is derived through the annual subsaision of its members. Additional funding is generated from investments, corporate sponsorships, voluntary donations, legacies and

the sale of its annual Christmas card and other merchandise.

The Trust is dependent on financial support from individuals, institutions and companies who share our charit able purpose. For information about how to help and the benefits of membership, which include a newsletter, a quarterfy Nigeria Digest with news on current affairs in Nigeria and various social fund-raising functions, contact the BNET secretariat at 27 Hill Street, Mayfair, London W1J 5LP United Kingdom.

Current BNET projects include:

(i) sponsorship of the National Teachers' Institute four-year distance learning programme leading to a National Certificate of Education. BNET sponsors one student from each of Nigeria's 36 states, as well as Abuja for the final three years of the course.

(ii) Sponsorship, in association with the Association of Commonwealth Universities, two visiting external examiners each year to the Departments of Education at two universities.

(iii) Sponsorship of school furniture and equipment for a refurbished laboratory at a school in Mirnga near Biu, Borno State, a school that has faced Boko Haram troubles

(iv) The delivery of several cartons of books and periodicals to the University of Jos Library following the devastating fire that burnt the original library to the ground in 2016.

(v) The donation of 15,000 school reading books to 60 schools throughout Nigeria.

(vi) Sponsorship since 2015 of the Agbado E-Learning hub in Lagos, including the provision of e-readers and solar panels to supply electricity to the hub.

(vii) Funding bore holes and water pumps for remote schools in the North of Nigeria.


